WHAT DOES RACCOON VALLEY BANK DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.	
What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: Social Security number and Payment History Credit History and Credit card or other debt Employment info and Transaction or loss history When you are no longer our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.	
How?	All financial companies need to share customer's personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customer's personal information; the reasons Raccoon Valley Bank chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. Raccoon Valley Bank has no affiliates. 		
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.		
	Raccoon Valley Bank does not share with non-affiliates so they can market to you.		
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. Raccoon Valley Bank doesn't jointly market.
